1 Binding - Habenicht, A. Photographien. Vienna, Habenicht, 1858. 49,5 : 46,5 : 7,5 cm. Brown leather Coffer with 8 metal fittings, 7 square metal fittings on spine, big metal fitting on front board in the middle round circle with the word 'Photografien', signed and dated A. Habenicht, Wien 1858. 3 800,--

Very rare, signed and dated - A. Habenicht, Wien 1858 - binding for a box to host photographs or related items. - This decoration style appears to be a gauffering (or goffering) technique combined with gold tooling, often used in fine leather bookbinding's. - This kind of decoration is common in Victorian-era bindings (mid-to-late 19th century), particularly for luxury books like Bibles, poetry collections, or photograph albums. The use of gauffering (heated blind tooling with added pigment) was particularly fashionable in Continental European and English bookbinding traditions. This pattern would typically be found on deluxe leather bindings, especially on the inside covers or spine. It might belong to a fine binding of a religious book, a poetry collection, or a Victorian-era photograph album.

First edition of an almost complete set in a stunning signed binding. -George Cruikshank's Comic Almanack was the most important of a number of comic almanacks of the late Regency period which parodied and subverted the popular almanack genre to poke fun at their educational aspirations and at society at large. The almanac is illustrated throughout with caricatures by Cruikshank, with his usual satirical flair and comic wit on full display. - Without volume 1850/1851, volume 1848/49 as often smaller, all uniformly bound in same size. - Besides the missing volume, still a desirable set in a beautiful binding in almost perfect condition. -MORAL: Wile we venerate what is deserving of veneration, let us not forget that quackery, knavery, bigotry, and superstition, always merit exposure and castigation.

Franz Cižek (1865-1946) is considered an outstanding reformer of art education. His Viennese youth art classes, which he founded in 1897 in close proximity to the Viennese Secessionists, became the center of a reform movement with lasting international impact. The appreciation and encouragement of children's creativity, which was able to develop in a supportive, enthusiastic environment, shook the authoritarian regulatory concepts of public education. Cižek's practical artistic work with children and his very successful exhibitions in Great Britain and the USA were noticed and carried forward to the present day, by Maria Montessori and the English Child Art movement as well as, to this day, by reform movements in Canada and the USA.

Durer applied the geometry to the painting and drawings and in the same way to architecture, lettering (design of Roman and Gothic letters are illustrated in the book) and some others ornamental forms. The book was originally published in German in 1525 and first Latin ed in Paris (1532), being our copy from the second Latin edition. 

In the book of Lindisfarne are merging the influences of the Roman and Celtic cultural aera to a unique work of art from the Italo-north Umbrian work of book art. The txt of the four gospels with the respective introductions and 16 canon plates present themselves on 259 leaves, a true treasury of insular art. Because of the special technique the pages blaze in spectacular colours. - The commentary volumes are by M.P. Brown with an introduction by Umberto Eco.

In 1900 he was awarded a silver medal for his bindings at the Universal exhibition, and, according to Flety, he was devoted to improving the craft of binding right up to his death. This painter is the only one who used this technique in his time. - In a very special full gilded leather binding with original color paintings on leather and added to the covers, two on the front (portrait of Columbus and mermaid at the bottom of the sea) and two on the back (bottom of the sea and Christian cross next to some palm trees.



Birnbaum visualizes the apocalypse in intensive and frightening pictures, it seems that he is foreseeing what will happen. - Societal collapse (also known as civilizational collapse or systems collapse) is the fall of a complex human society characterized by the loss of cultural identity and of social complexity as an adaptive system, the downfall of government, and the rise of violence. Possible causes of a societal collapse include natural catastrophe, war, pestilence, famine, economic



collapse, population decline or overshoot, mass migration, incompetent leaders, and sabotage by rival civilizations. A collapsed society may revert to a more primitive state, be absorbed into a stronger society, or completely disappear.

On original leaf of Gutenberg's famous Catholicon, Folio 359 leaf from an incomplete paper copy. With a distinguish provenance, Exlibris Estelle Doheny. -The Catholicon is a Latin dictionary with grammar compiled by a Genoese Dominican, Johannes Balbus, who dated the completion of his work 7 March 1286. Almost one-third longer than the Latin Bible, it remained the standard Latin dictionary until the 16th century. The first edition has, like the Gutenberg Bible, separate issues on paper and, more expensively, on vellum. Its distinguishing feature is that the first line-pair on the first page, giving the work's title, is printed in red. The anonymous colophon praises God, "who often reveals to the lowly what he conceals from the wise." This and other pious elements in the colophon have been taken to express the modest mind of Johann Gutenberg, who treats the discovery of typography as a



divine gift. This contrasts with the pride of Fust and Schoeffer, who in the colophon of the 1457 Psalter put forth their names prominently.

A handsome Pruss edition of the famous Fasciculus Temporum, with the beautiful full page woodcut of Rolewinck presenting his book to the seated Holy Roman Emperor Frederick III on the verso of the title page, numerous other woodcuts including full page large woodcut of Jesus surrounded by 4 walls of text and 4 roundels representing the 4 apostles. This is Johan Pruss's last Latin edition of the wildly popular Fasciculus Temporum by Werner Rolewinck, printed not before April 6, 1490, the date of Matthias Corvinus King of Hungary's death as recorded in the last entry in the book. -With two-line dedication below the title, dated 1596. -Rolewinck's chronological history of the world-one of the earliest examples of a hypertext, with annotations. The chronology follows a double timeline, measuring time from both the Creation and the birth of Christ, demanding



a remarkably complex typographical layout and utilizing "a system of coordinated circles to locate biblical, classical, and modern rulers and writers in the flow of historical time" (Grafton). - Hayn-Cop. 6915; Proctor 571; Schreiber 5120. - A mint copy, in this state of conservation rare.



During his papacy, Pope Innocent issued a papal bull on witchcraft named Summis desiderantes affectibus. In March 1489, Cem, the captive brother of Bayezid II, the sultan of the Ottoman Empire, came into Innocent's custody.



Viewing his brother as a rival, the Sultan paid Pope Innocent not to set him free. The amount he paid to Pope Innocent was 120,000 crowns (an amount equal to all of the annual revenue to the Vatican) in addition to some holy relics and another sum of money to be paid annually. Any time the Sultan threatened war against the Christian Balkans, Innocent threatened to release his brother. On 28 January 1495, Cem was released by Innocent's successor, Pope Alexander VI, into the custody of King Charles's army.





Gonzalo Fernández de Oviedo y Valdés (August 1478 -1557), commonly known as Oviedo, was a Spanish soldier, historian, writer, botanist and colonist. Oviedo participated in the Spanish colonization of the West Indies, arriving in the first few years after Christopher Columbus became the first European to arrive at the islands in 1492. Oviedo's chronicle Historia general de las India's, forms one of the few primary sources about it, and introduced Europeans to the hammock, the pineapple, and tobacco as well as creating influential representations of the colonized peoples of the region. It is through the Historia that Europeans came to learn about the hammock, pineapple, tobacco, and barbecue, among other things used by the Native Americans that he encountered. The first illustration of a pineapple is credited to him. The Historia, though written in a diffuse style, furnishes a

Originally, one auscultated and percutated the ear directly at certain parts of the body without using an auditory tube also tapped there with the finger without placing an intermediate body, but it was soon discovered that a better sound could be heard if one placed the fingers underneath, and that was the reason for the invention of the plessimeter (...)" (normalized Signature). The following describes the manuscript a.d.H. of the unidentified surgeon - possibly Karl Rochowansky, who worked at the Garrison Hospital in Milan around the middle of the century - the listening technique improved by the stethoscope and plessimeter (small sketches of both can be found in the manuscript). - Leopold Auenbrugger's "immortal achievement is the invention



and precise development of percussion, a method of 'discovering hidden breast diseases by tapping on the chest', a process that made him the founder of modern diagnostic.





Typical memorabilia include photographs, printed media, and artwork. Scrapbook albums are often decorated and frequently contain extensive journal entries or written descriptions. - Keeping a scrapbook organizes your pictures and helps you keep a journal of memories. Even day to day life, when recorded, becomes history.



Photos and memorabilia can be preserved for generations, if stored properly.
